Overview

Johnson Controls has confirmed a vulnerability impacting exacqVision Client, exacqVision Server key exchanges, AES Keys.

Impact

Under certain circumstances the communication between exacqVision Client and exacqVision Server will use insufficient key length and exchange.

• exacqVision Client, exacqVision Server, all versions

Mitigation
